ROAD TRAFFIC

**The A47 Trunk Road (Acle, Norfolk) Eastbound Exit Slip Road
(Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2012**

Made - - - - *27th February 2012*

Coming into force - - *5th March 2012*

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A47 Trunk Road (“the A47”) and connecting roads, is satisfied that traffic on one of those connecting roads in the County of Norfolk should be prohibited because works are proposed to be executed nearby:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a) hereby makes the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as the A47 Trunk Road (Acle, Norfolk) Eastbound Exit Slip Road (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2012 and shall come into force on 5th March 2012.

2. Subject as mentioned in article 3 of this Order no person shall, during a period of 10 hours starting at 20:00 hours on Monday 12th March 2012, or on any subsequent day until junction improvement works comprising road marking, sign installation, kerb re-alignment, drainage maintenance and vegetation clearance have been completed, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in the A47 eastbound exit slip road leading to the B1140 Reedham Road/Norwich Road Roundabout in Acle.

3. The provisions of article 2 above shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall, from time to time, be indicated by traffic signs and shall not apply to a vehicle being used in connection with the said works or for police, fire and rescue authority, ambulance, traffic officer or winter service maintenance purposes.
