**The Courts Reform (Scotland) Act 2014 (Consequential Provisions and Modifications) Order 2015**

**Pensions Appeal Tribunal for Scotland**

9.—(1) The functions of the Scottish Ministers<sup>(1)</sup> referred to in paragraph (2) are transferred to the Scottish Courts and Tribunals Service.

(2) Those functions are—

- (a) the provision of premises for the purposes of carrying out the functions of a Pensions Appeal Tribunal (constituted under the Schedule to the Pensions Appeal Tribunals Act 1943<sup>(2)</sup>);
- (b) the provision of staff to assist a Pensions Appeal Tribunal to carry out its functions; and
- (c) the funding of payments made by a Pensions Appeal Tribunal under rule 26 of the Pensions Appeal Tribunals (Scotland) Rules 1981<sup>(3)</sup>.
