The Courts Reform (Scotland) Act 2014 (Consequential Provisions and Modifications) Order 2015

Pensions Appeal Tribunal for Scotland

9.—(1) The functions of the Scottish Ministers(1) referred to in paragraph (2) are transferred to the Scottish Courts and Tribunals Service.

(2) Those functions are—

- (a) the provision of premises for the purposes of carrying out the functions of a Pensions Appeal Tribunal (constituted under the Schedule to the Pensions Appeal Tribunals Act 1943(2));
- (b) the provision of staff to assist a Pensions Appeal Tribunal to carry out its functions; and
- (c) the funding of payments made by a Pensions Appeal Tribunal under rule 26 of the Pensions Appeal Tribunals (Scotland) Rules 1981(**3**).
