Scrutiny History:

1. The then Department of Energy and Climate Change (DECC) submitted Explanatory Memorandum 14450/11 on 19 October 2011 concerning a proposal for a Council Directive laying down basic safety standards for protection against the dangers arising from exposure to ionising radiation. Following some correspondence between the Committees and the Minister it was cleared by the Lords European Union Select Committee on 22 May 2013, and by the Commons European Scrutiny Select Committee on 2 July 2013.
