**Amendments to the Public Sector Bodies (Websites and Mobile Applications) (No. 2)  
Accessibility Regulations 2018**

**4.** For regulation 9 substitute—

“**9.** A website or mobile application of a public sector body will be presumed to be in conformity with the accessibility requirement to the extent that the website or mobile application conforms to Level A and AA Success Criteria as set out in the Web Content Accessibility Guidelines recommended by the World Wide Web Consortium, as amended from time to time<sup>(1)</sup>.”
