1290 CHAPTER 1 18 Edw 1

III ^{X1}Mortmain prohibited.

..... ^{F1} And It is to wit, that this Statute extendeth
but only to Lands [^{X2}holden] in Fee Simple; and that it extendeth to the time coming;
and it shall begin to take effect at the Feast of Saint Andrew the Apostle next coming.
[Given the eighteenth year of the Reign of King Edward, Son to King Henry.]
