DEVELOPMENT FUNCTIONS OF NEW TOWN COMMISSIONS

27 Power of new town commissions to recover certain expenses from district councils.

- (1) Where in any ...^{F1} district ...^{F1}, a new town commission ...^{F1}
- (a) after consultation with the [^{F2} district] council, and
 - (b) with the approval of the Ministry,

incur expenses in the carrying out, for the purposes of the new town, of development of a kind the carrying out of which in relation to that district ...^{F1} is a function of the [^{F2} district] council, the [^{F2} district] council shall pay to the new town commission, on such terms as may be approved by the Ministry with the concurrence of the Ministry of Finance, a sum equal in amount to those expenses.

- (2) Any question arising as to the amount payable by a [^{F2} district] council under subsection (1) shall be referred to arbitration^{F3}
