DEVELOPMENT FUNCTIONS OF NEW TOWN COMMISSIONS

27 Power of new town commissions to recover certain expenses from district councils.

- (1) Where in any \dots^{F_1} district \dots^{F_1} , a new town commission \dots^{F_1}
 - (a) after consultation with the $[^{F2}$ district] council, and
 - (b) with the approval of the Ministry,

incur expenses in the carrying out, for the purposes of the new town, of development of a kind the carrying out of which in relation to that district \dots^{F1} is a function of the [^{F2} district] council, the [^{F2} district] council shall pay to the new town commission, on such terms as may be approved by the Ministry with the concurrence of the Ministry of Finance, a sum equal in amount to those expenses.

(2) Any question arising as to the amount payable by a $[F^2 \text{ district}]$ council under subsection (1) shall be referred to arbitration F^3
