## **1968 CHAPTER 10**

## [<sup>F1</sup>5A Fees of required interpreter.

Notwithstanding anything to the contrary contained in this Act, where in any criminal proceedings an interpreter is required because of a defendant's lack of English, the expenses properly incurred on his employment shall, in accordance with rules made pursuant to section 7, be defrayed by the [<sup>F2</sup>Department of Justice].]
