

Electoral Law Act (Northern Ireland) 1969

1969 CHAPTER 26

N.I.

An Act to extend the local government franchise; to lower the age at which persons may be registered as electors and vote at parliamentary and local government elections; to postpone triennial elections; to alter the years in which registers of parliamentary and local electors are published and in which polling station schemes are prepared; and for purposes connected with the matters aforesaid or any of them. [25th November 1969]
