Part 6: Information, Advice and Guidance

Section 133: Power to require application-to-acceptance information

- 411. This section makes provision for the Welsh Ministers to require, by notice, "applicationto-acceptance information" from bodies providing admissions services to Welsh higher education providers for use for "qualifying research". The Welsh Ministers may direct this information is to be provided either to themselves or to the Commission. This section also defines "application-to-acceptance" information and "qualifying research".
- 412. This section sets out what a notice may require including, but not limited to, the time within which the person must provide the information. Further, the Welsh Ministers may enforce a request for such information by application for an injunction.
