

Scottish Public Services Ombudsman Act 2002 2002 asp 11

Supplementary

24 Orders in Council: general

- (1) An Order in Council made under any provision of this Act may include such supplementary, incidental, consequential, transitional, transitory or saving provision as Her Majesty considers necessary or expedient.
- (2) No recommendation to make an Order in Council under section 3(2) [^{F1}or (7)], 8(2) or, where the Order contains provisions which add to, replace or omit any part of the text of an Act, 25(2) is to be made to Her Majesty in Council unless a draft of the Order has been laid before, and approved by resolution of, the Parliament.
- (3) An Order in Council under section 6(2), 25(2) (except where subsection (2) of this section applies) or 26(2) is subject to annulment in pursuance of a resolution of the Parliament.
