Abolition of bridge tolls

1 Forth Road Bridge

- (1) In the Order contained in the Schedule to the Forth Road Bridge Order Confirmation Act 1947 (c.iv), section 69 (penalties) is repealed.
- (2) In the Order contained in the Schedule to the Forth Road Bridge Order Confirmation Act 1958 (c.vi), the following provisions are repealed—
 - (a) in section 2(b) (interpretation), the first proviso,
 - (b) in section 34(2)(b) (general reserve fund), the words from the beginning to “Order”,
 - (c) Part V (tolls).

2 Tay Road Bridge

In the Order contained in the Schedule to the Tay Road Bridge Order Confirmation Act 1991 (c.iv), the following provisions are repealed—

- (a) in section 41(1) (application of revenues of undertaking), the words “revenue received by the Joint Board from tolls under this Order, and all other”,
- (b) Part VI (tolls),
- (c) in section 57 (power to make byelaws), paragraph (f),
- (d) in Part II of Schedule 1 (provisions as to meetings and proceedings), paragraph 10(2)(e).
