INTERPRETATION AND OPERATION OF WELSH LEGISLATION

Amendment, repeal and revocation of legislation

37 Meaning of repeal and revocation in this Part

- (1) In this Part, references to repealing or revoking an enactment or abolishing a rule of law include—
 - (a) substituting anything for the enactment or rule (or for any part of it);
 - (b) limiting the application or effect of the enactment or rule;
 - (c) providing for the enactment or rule to cease to have effect.
- (2) For the purposes of sections 34 to 36 (but not section 33)—
 - (a) the expiry of a temporary [FIAct of Senedd Cymru] is to be treated as a repeal of the Act by an [FIAct of Senedd Cymru] or a Welsh subordinate instrument;
 - (b) the expiry of a temporary Welsh subordinate instrument is to be treated as a revocation of the instrument by an [F1Act of Senedd Cymru] or a Welsh subordinate instrument.
