#### WATER SUPPLY

#### *Supply and use of water*

### 18 Use of water

(1) Subject to—

- (a) an agreement under section 19(1); and
- (b) section 9A of the Water (Scotland) Act 1980 (c. 45) (charging for emergency use of water),

[<sup>F1</sup>SFRS] may use any suitable supply of water for the purposes mentioned in section 17(2).

(2) [<sup>F2</sup>SFRS] shall pay reasonable compensation for water used by virtue of subsection (1).
