SCHEDULE 1 SCOTTISH COMMISSION FOR HUMAN RIGHTS

General powers

- 8 (1) The Commission may do anything which appears necessary or expedient for the purpose of, or in connection with, or which appears conducive to, the exercise of its functions.
 - (2) In particular, the Commission may—
 - (a) enter into contracts, and
 - [^{F1}(b) acquire and dispose of land and other property,]
 - $[^{F2}(3)$ The exercise of the power to acquire or dispose of land is subject to the approval of the Parliamentary corporation.]
