65 Information from professional association

The [FILord President of the Court of Session or any sheriff principal] may require the professional association to provide any information the [FILORD President or, as the case may be, sheriff principal] considers necessary or proper for the purposes of—

- (a) any inspection under section 66 of this Act;
- (b) any investigation under section [F379(2) of the 1987 Act]; or
- [^{F4}(c) any disciplinary proceedings brought under section 79(3) of that Act.]
