[FIThe competent authority] shall take the necessary measures to prevent or reduce to a minimum any delay during transport or suffering by animals when unforeseeable circumstances impede the application of this Regulation. [FIThe competent authority] shall ensure that special arrangements are made at the place of transfers, exit points and border inspection posts to give priority to the transport of animals.
