[^{X1} CHAPTER 3

Authorisations in the supply chain

Article 65

Obligation of holders of authorisations

Holders of an authorisation, as well as downstream users referred to in Article 56(2) including the substances in a [^{F1}mixture], shall include the authorisation number on the label before they place the substance or a [^{F1}mixture] containing the substance on the market for an authorised use ^{F2}.... This shall be done without delay once the authorisation number has been made publicly available in accordance with Article 64(9).

Article 66

Downstream users

1 Downstream users using a substance in accordance with Article 56(2) shall notify the Agency within three months of the first supply of the substance.

2 The Agency shall establish and keep up to date a register of downstream users who have made a notification in accordance with paragraph 1. The Agency shall grant access to this register to the [^{F3}appropriate authorities].]
