Commission Regulation (EC) No 79/2007 of 26 January 2007 on the issue of import licences against applications lodged from 15 to 19 January 2007 under the tariff quota opened by Regulation (EC) No 2021/2006 for rice originating in the ACP States and the overseas countries and territories (OCTs)

Article 1

- For import licence applications for rice originating in the ACP States/OCTs covered by quota serial numbers 09.4187, 09.4188, 09.4189 and 09.4190 as referred to in Regulation (EC) No 2021/2006 lodged from 15 to 19 January 2007, licences shall be issued for the quantities applied for, multiplied by the award coefficients set out in the Annex to this Regulation.
- The quantities available for the sub-period January 2007 to be carried over to the next sub-period and the total quantities available for the sub-period May 2007 shall be as set out in the Annex.

Article 2

This Regulation shall enter into force on the day of its publication in the *Official Journal* of the European Union.

This Regulation shall be binding in its entirety and directly applicable in all Member States.
