**The Flags Regulations (Northern Ireland) 2000**

*Coming into force 11th November 2000*

**THE FLAGS REGULATIONS (NORTHERN IRELAND) 2000**

1. Citation, commencement and interpretation
  2. Flying of flags at government buildings on specified days
  3. Flying of flags at government buildings on the occasion of a visit by a Head of State other than Her Majesty the Queen
  4. Flying of flags at government buildings on the occasion of a visit by Her Majesty the Queen
  5. Manner of flying flags required or permitted to be flown by regulations 2, 3 or 4
  6. Flying of flags at half mast
  7. Discretion to fly flags at government buildings
  8. Where Regulation 2(4) or 3(2) requires or permits the flying...
  9. Prohibition on the flying of flags other than in accordance with the Regulations
