**2.**—(1) This paragraph applies for the interpretation of the Table in paragraph 1.

(2) Personal information contained in records kept by the Northern Ireland Housing Executive is "held for any purpose of the Executive's tenancies" if it is held for any purpose of the relationship of landlord and tenant of a dwelling which subsists, has subsisted or may subsist between the Executive and any individual who is, has been or, as the case may be, has applied to be, a tenant of the Executive; and, for the purposes of Part II of this Order, information about any member of the individual's family held for any purpose of that relationship or potential relationship shall be treated as information of which he is the subject and accessible by him accordingly.
