# The Sexual Offences (Northern Ireland) Order 2008

### PART 3

#### SEXUAL OFFENCES AGAINST CHILDREN

Sexual offences against children under 16

### Sexual activity with a child

- **16.**—(1) A person aged 18 or over (A) commits an offence if—
  - (a) he intentionally touches another person (B),
  - (b) the touching is sexual, and
  - (c) either—
    - (i) B is under 16 and A does not reasonably believe that B is 16 or over, or
    - (ii) B is under 13.
- (2) A person guilty of an offence under this Article, if the touching involved—
  - (a) penetration of B's anus or vagina with a part of A's body or anything else,
  - (b) penetration of B's mouth with A's penis,
  - (c) penetration of A's anus or vagina with a part of B's body, or
  - (d) penetration of A's mouth with B's penis,

is liable, on conviction on indictment, to imprisonment for a term not exceeding 14 years.

- (3) Unless paragraph (2) applies, a person guilty of an offence under this Article is liable—
  - (a) on summary conviction, to imprisonment for a term not exceeding 6 months or a fine not exceeding the statutory maximum or both;
  - (b) on conviction on indictment, to imprisonment for a term not exceeding 14 years.
