The Criminal Justice (Northern Ireland) Order 2004 (Commencement No. 3) Order 2008

The Secretary of State makes the following Order, in exercise of the powers conferred by Article 1(3) of the Criminal Justice (Northern Ireland) Order 2004 (1).

### **Citation and Interpretation**

**1.**—(1) This Order may be cited as the Criminal Justice (Northern Ireland) Order 2004 (Commencement No. 3) Order 2008.

(2) In this Order

"the 2004 Order" means the Criminal Justice (Northern Ireland) Order 2004

#### Commencement

**2.** The provisions of the 2004 Order specified in the Schedule to this Order shall come into operation on  $2^{nd}$  February 2009.
