# The Food Hygiene Rating (Fee and Fixed Penalty Amount) Order (Northern Ireland) 2016

Laid before the Assembly in draft

Made - - - - 8th December 2016

Coming into operation in accordance with Article 1(1)

The Department of Health(1), in exercise of the powers conferred by sections 4(7)(c) and paragraph 4 of the Schedule to the Food Hygiene Rating Act (Northern Ireland) 2016(2), makes the following Order.

## Citation, commencement and interpretation

- 1.—(1) This Order may be cited as the Food Hygiene Rating (Fee and Fixed Penalty Amount) Order (Northern Ireland) 2016 and comes into operation forthwith.
  - (2) In this Order "the Act" means the Food Hygiene Rating Act (Northern Ireland) 2016

#### Fee for re-rating

**2.** An application made to a district council for a review of a food business establishment's food hygiene rating under section 4 of the Act must be accompanied by a fee of £150.00.

### Amount of fixed penalty

**3.** The fixed penalty in respect of an alleged offence under section 10(1) or (2) of the Act is £200.00.
