MEDICINES

The Human Medicines (Amendment) Regulations 2018

Made - - - - *9th February 2018*

Laid before Parliament *22nd February 2018*

Coming into operation *1st April 2018*

The Secretary of State and the Department of Health in Northern Ireland⁽¹⁾ make the following Regulations. They do so in the exercise of the powers conferred by section 2(2) and (5) of the European Communities Act 1972⁽²⁾, having been designated for the purposes of section 2(2) of the Act in relation to medicinal products⁽³⁾.
