**The Mental Health (1986 Order) (Amendment  
No. 2) Order (Northern Ireland) 2021**

*Coming into operation* *10th May 2021*

The Department of Health<sup>(1)</sup>, in exercise of the powers conferred by Article 64(2) of the Mental Health (Northern Ireland) Order 1986<sup>(2)</sup>, makes the following Order:

**Citation and commencement**

1. This Order may be cited as the Mental Health (1986 Order) (Amendment No. 2) Order (Northern Ireland) 2021 and shall come into operation on 10th May 2021.

**Amendment of Article 64(1)(b) of the Mental Health (Northern Ireland) Order 1986**

2. In Article 64(1)(b)(3), for “six months” substitute “three months”.

This Order varies the length of the period which must elapse for a second opinion to be required for the continued administration of medicine to detained patients from six months to three months.
