#### **EXPLANATORY NOTE**

This Order brings into force section 80 of the Transport (Scotland) Act 2001.

Section 80 provides that a director, manager, secretary or similar officer of a body corporate or a partner of a Scottish partnership may be required to pay a civil penalty under the Transport (Scotland) Act 2001 where an act or omission has been done with their consent or connivance or where the act or omission is attributable to them.
