The Scottish Ministers, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 30(2) of the International Criminal Court (Scotland) Act 2001(1), hereby make the following Order:

1. This Order may be cited as the International Criminal Court (Scotland) Act 2001 (Commencement) Order 2001.

2. The provisions of the International Criminal Court (Scotland) Act 2001, in so far as not already in force, shall come into force on 17th December 2001.
