The National Health Service Reform (Scotland)  
Act 2004 (Commencement No. 1) Order 2004

Made - - - - 28th July 2004

The Scottish Ministers, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 12(1) and (2) of the National Health Service Reform (Scotland) Act 2004<sup>(1)</sup> and of all other powers enabling them in that behalf, hereby make the following Order:

**Citation**

1. This Order may be cited as the National Health Service Reform (Scotland) Act 2004 (Commencement No. 1) Order 2004.

**Appointed day**

2. The day appointed for the coming into force of the following provisions of the National Health Service Reform (Scotland) Act 2004 is 30th July 2004:—

- (a) section 11(1), so far as relating to schedule 1, paragraph 2; and
- (b) schedule 1, paragraph 2.

## EXPLANATORY NOTE

*(This note is not part of the Order)*

This Order brings into force on 30th July 2004 paragraph 2 of Schedule 1 to the [National Health Service Reform \(Scotland\) Act 2004 \(asp 7\)](#) (“the Act”) and section 11(1) of that Act so far as it relates to that paragraph.

Paragraph 2 of Schedule 1 to the Act amends the National Health Service (Private Finance Act) [1997 \(c. 56\)](#) so as to replace references to National Health Service Trusts with references to Health Boards, Special Health Boards and the Common Services Agency.
