The Scottish Ministers, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 26 of the International Criminal Court (Scotland) Act 2001<sup>(1)</sup> and of all other powers enabling them in that behalf, hereby make the following Regulations:

**Citation and commencement**

**1.** These Regulations may be cited as the International Criminal Court (Enforcement of Fines, Forfeiture and Reparation Orders) (Scotland) (Revocation) Regulations 2004 and shall come into force on 9th October 2004.

**Revocation**

**2.** The International Criminal Court (Enforcement of Fines, Forfeiture and Reparation Orders) (Scotland) Regulations 2004<sup>(2)</sup> are hereby revoked.
