The Licensing (Procedure) (Scotland) Regulations 2007

Meaning of “neighbouring land”

4. Land is “neighbouring land” for the purposes of section 21(1)(a) if—
- (a) it is within 4 metres in any direction of any boundary of the premises to which the application in question relates; and
 - (b) it is not part of—
 - (i) a road (within the meaning of section 107 of the New Roads and Street Works Act 1991 ^{M1});
 - (ii) land covered by water; or
 - (iii) a railway line.
