**The Pollution Prevention and

PART I

GENERAL

Electronic communications

- 9.—(1) In these Regulations—
- (a) “writing” includes electronic communications within the meaning of section 15 (general interpretation) of the Electronic Communications Act 2000 ^{M1}, and
 - (b) a reference to a form includes an electronic form.
- (2) Where an application is sent electronically—
- (a) any fee, map or plan that is required to accompany the application may be sent to SEPA separately, and
 - (b) the application is not be treated as having being received by SEPA until the last thing so required has also been received.
