**The Seed (Fees) (Scotland) Amendment Regulations 2022**

The Scottish Ministers make the following Regulations in exercise of the powers conferred by sections 16(1), (1A), and 36 of the Plant Varieties and Seeds Act 1964(1) and all other powers enabling them to do so.

In accordance with section 16(1) of that Act, they have consulted with representatives of such interests as appear to them to be concerned.

**Citation and commencement**

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Seed (Fees) (Scotland) Amendment Regulations 2022 and come into force on 1 July 2022.

**Amendment of the Seed (Fees) (Scotland) Regulations 2018**

2. For schedule 1 (fees for matters relating to the Seed Marketing Regulations) of the Seed (Fees) (Scotland) Regulations 2018(2) substitute—

## EXPLANATORY NOTE

*(This note is not part of the Regulations)*

These Regulations amend the Seed (Fees) Scotland Regulations 2018 (“the Principal Regulations”), which prescribe fees for matters relating to:

- the Vegetable Seeds Regulations 1993, the Oil and Fibre Plant Seed (Scotland) Regulations 2004, the Cereal Seed (Scotland) Regulations 2005, the Fodder Plant Seed (Scotland) Regulations 2005 and the Beet Seed (Scotland) (No. 2) Regulations 2010 “the Seed Marketing Regulations”); and
- the Seed (Licensing and Enforcement etc.) (Scotland) Regulations 2016.

Regulation 2 amends schedule 1 of the Principal Regulations (fees for matters relating to the Seed Marketing Regulations).

The changes to the fees in schedule 1 of the Principal Regulations are as follows:
