



Papua New Guinea, Western Samoa and Nauru (Miscellaneous Provisions) Act 1980

1980 CHAPTER 2

An Act to make provision in connection with the attainment by Papua New Guinea of independence within the Commonwealth and with the membership of the Commonwealth of Western Samoa and Nauru. [31st January 1980]

1 Commonwealth citizenship.

^{F1}(2) It is hereby declared that Papua New Guinea has never been a colony within the meaning of the ^{M1}British Nationality Act 1948.

(3) In accordance with section 3(3) of the ^{M2}West Indies Act 1967 it is hereby declared that this section and section 3(2) below extend to all associated states.

3 Miscellaneous amendments and repeals.
