[^{F1}11C References under section 11: further supplementary provisions

- (1) Section 117 of the Enterprise Act 2002 (false or misleading information) shall apply in relation to functions under this Act as it applies in relation to functions under Part 3 of that Act but as if, in subsections (1)(a) and (2), [^{F2}—
 - (a) the words “, OFCOM or the Secretary of State” were omitted, and
 - (b) for the words “their functions” there were substituted “ its functions ”.]
- (2) Section 125 of the Enterprise Act 2002 (offences by bodies corporate) shall apply for the purposes of this Act as it applies for the purposes of Part 3 of that Act.
- (3) For the purposes of section 12 below, a conclusion contained in a report of the [^{F3}CMA] is to be disregarded if the conclusion is not that of at least two-thirds of the members of the group constituted [^{F4}by the chair of the CMA for the purpose of carrying out the functions of the CMA with respect to the reference].]
