#### SATISFACTION AND ENFORCEMENT

##### *Sums adjudged to be paid by an order*

#### 94 Effect of committal on arrears.

Where a person is committed to custody under this Part of this Act for failure to pay a sum due under [<sup>F1</sup>a magistrates' court maintenance order], then, unless the court that commits him otherwise directs, no arrears shall accrue under the order while he is in custody.
