## Mental Health (Amendment) Act 1982

- Notwithstanding the repeal by this Act of section 4(3) of the Representation of the People Act 1949, that subsection shall continue to have effect instead of section 7 of this Act until the coming into force (on 1st April 1983) of section 62 of and Schedule 2 (electoral registration and voting in case of voluntary mental patients) to the Mental Health (Amendment) Act 1982; and the following provisions of this Act shall not have effect until that coming into force—
  - (a) sections 5(3) and 7;
  - (b) section 19(1) and (4), 32(1), 33(2) and 62(1) to the extent that they provide for or refer to a patient's declaration under section 7;
  - (c) paragraph 27 of Schedule 8; and
  - (d) Part II of Schedule 9 to the extent that it repeals certain provisions of the Mental Health (Amendment) Act 1982.
