1985 CHAPTER 38

An Act to prohibit female circumcision.

[16th July 1985]

FIF2Be it enacted by the Queen's most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Lords Spiritual and Temporal, and Commons, in this present Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—
