#### 40 Official seal for share certificates, etc.

A company [<sup>F1</sup>which has a common seal] may have, for use for sealing securities issued by the company and for sealing documents creating or evidencing securities so issued, an official seal which is a facsimile of [<sup>F2</sup>its common seal] with the addition on its face of the word "Securities".

[<sup>F3</sup>The official seal when duly affixed to a document has the same effect as the company's common seal.]
