PART I

REPRESENTATION AND ASSESSMENT

- 4 Services under s. 2 of the 1970 Act: duty to consider needs of disabled persons.
 - [F1(1)] When requested to do so by—
 - (a) a disabled person,
 - (b) his authorised representative, or
 - (c) any person who provides care for him in the circumstances mentioned in section 8,
 - a local authority [F2in England] shall decide whether the needs of the disabled person call for the provision by the authority of any services in accordance with [F3section 2(4)] of the 1970 Act (provision of welfare services).
 - [^{F4}(2) ^{F5}... This section applies only if the disabled person is aged under 18.]
