Effective date of [F1calculation]

- 11 (1) A [F2maintenance calculation] shall take effect on such date as may be determined in accordance with regulations made by the Secretary of State.
- (2) That date may be earlier than the date on which the [F1calculation] is made.

Consolidated applications and [F1]calculations]

- 14 [F4(1)] The Secretary of State may by regulations provide—
- (a) for two or more applications for maintenance [F1]calculations] to be treated, in prescribed circumstances, as a single application; and
 - (b) for the replacement, in prescribed circumstances, of a [F2]maintenance calculation] made on the application of one person by a later [F2]maintenance calculation] made on the application of that or any other person.

- 15 Where [F6the Secretary of State] is satisfied that the circumstances of a case require different amounts of child support maintenance to be assessed in respect of different periods, he may make separate maintenance [F1]calculations] each expressed to have effect in relation to a different specified period.
