1994 CHAPTER 40

PART III

SUPPLEMENTARY

80 Financial provisions.

- (1) There shall be paid out of money provided by Parliament—
 - (a) any sums required by a Minister of the Crown, an office-holder [FI or the Forestry Commissioners] for making payments under contracts entered into under or by virtue of Part II of this Act;
 - (b) any administrative expenses incurred by a Minister of the Crown or officeholder in consequence of the provisions of this Act; and
 - (c) any increase attributable to this Act in the sums so payable under any other Act.
- (2) In this section—

"Minister of the Crown" has the same meaning as in M1 the Ministers of the Crown Act 1975;

"office-holder" has the same meaning as in Part II of this Act.
