HOMELESSNESS

Homelessness and threatened homelessness

178 Meaning of associated person. **E+W**

- (1) For the purposes of this Part, a person is associated with another person if-
 - (a) they are or have been married to each other;
 - $[^{F1}(aa)$ they are or have been civil partners of each other;]
 - (b) they are cohabitants or former cohabitants;
 - (c) they live or have lived in the same household;
 - (d) they are relatives;
 - (e) they have agreed to marry one another (whether or not that agreement has been terminated);
 - [^{F2}(ea) they have entered into a civil partnership agreement between them (whether or not that agreement has been terminated);]
 - (f) in relation to a child, each of them is a parent of the child or has, or has had, parental responsibility for the child.
- (2) If a child has been adopted or has been freed for adoption by virtue of any of the enactments mentioned in section 16(1) of the ^{MI}Adoption Act 1976, two persons are also associated with each other for the purposes of this Part if—
 - (a) one is a natural parent of the child or a parent of such a natural parent, and
 - (b) the other is the child or a person—
 - (i) who has become a parent of the child by virtue of an adoption order or who has applied for an adoption order, or
 - (ii) with whom the child has at any time been placed for adoption.

(3) In this section—

"adoption order" has the meaning given by section 72(1) of the Adoption Act 1976;

"child" means a person under the age of 18 years;

[^{F3}"civil partnership agreement" has the meaning given by section 73 of the Civil Partnership Act 2004;]

[^{F4}"cohabitants" means—

- (a) a man and a woman who, although not married to each other, are living together as husband and wife, or
- (b) two people of the same sex who, although not civil partners of each other, are living together as if they were civil partners;

and "former cohabitants" shall be construed accordingly;]

"parental responsibility" has the same meaning as in the ^{M2}Children Act 1989; and

"relative", in relation to a person, means-

- (a) the father, mother, stepfather, stepmother, son, daughter, stepson, stepdaughter, grandmother, grandfather, grandson or granddaughter of that person or of that person's [^{F5} spouse, civil partner, former spouse or former civil partner], or
- (b) the brother, sister, uncle, aunt, niece or nephew (whether of the full blood or of the half blood or by [^{F6} marriage or civil partnership]) of that person or of that person's [^{F5} spouse, civil partner, former spouse or former civil partner],

and includes, in relation to a person who is living or has lived with another person as husband and wife, a person who would fall within paragraph (a) or (b) if the parties were married to each other.
