- (1) [F2Scottish Natural Heritage (in this Act referred to as "SNH") has the following general aims and purposes in relation to deer]—
 - (a) in accordance with the provisions of this Act [F3 to], further the conservation, control and sustainable management of deer in Scotland, and keep under review all matters, including their welfare, relating to deer; and
 - (b) [F4to] exercise such other functions as are conferred on [F5it] by or under this Act or any other enactment.
- [F6(1A) In this Act references to SNH 's deer functions are to the functions relating to deer conferred on it by or under this Act or any other enactment.]
 - (2) It shall be the duty of [F7SNH], in exercising [F8its deer] functions, to take such account as may be appropriate in the circumstances of—
 - (a) the size and density of the deer population and its impact on the natural heritage;
 - (b) the needs of agriculture and forestry; and
 - (c) the interests of owners and occupiers of land.

3 Power of [F7SNH] to facilitate exercise of functions.

- (1) [F7SNH] shall have power—
 - (a) to issue guidance or advice, whether general or particular, to any person or organisation; and
 - (b) to conduct, or to collaborate with any person or organisation which is conducting—
 - (i) any research, inquiry or investigation into questions of practical or scientific importance; or
 - (ii) any experiment, trial or demonstration,

relating to the conservation, control or sustainable management of deer or to any other aspect of [F7SNH's][F12deer] functions.

(2) For the avoidance of doubt, it is provided that [F7SNH] may exercise the powers conferred by subsection (1) above in relation to the general welfare of deer, in so far as that matter is not otherwise included in [F13its] functions under this Act.

4 Appointment of panels.

- (1) Subject to the approval of the Secretary of State, [F7SNH] may appoint for any locality a panel for the purposes of this section consisting of such number of persons, not exceeding nine, as [F14it considers] appropriate, one of whom shall act as chairman.
- (2) Before making an appointment under subsection (1) above, [F7SNH] may afford to such persons or organisations as [F15it thinks] fit an opportunity to suggest the name of any person who would in [F16its] view be an appropriate person for such an appointment.
- (3) Where [F7SNH][F17has] sought suggestions as mentioned in subsection (2) above, [F18it] shall consider any such suggestions before making an appointment under subsection (1) above.
- (4) [F7SNH] may appoint a member of [F7SNH] or a member of [F7SNH's] staff to act as observer to the panel for the purposes of—
 - (a) sitting with the panel at any meeting;
 - (b) taking part in their discussions; and
 - (c) informing [F7SNH] of information arising during and decisions taken at such meetings.
- (5) An observer appointed under subsection (4) above shall not be a member of the panel.
- (6) [F7SNH] may refer to any such panel any matter relating to the [F19deer] functions of [F7SNH], and it shall be the duty of the panel to advise [F7SNH] on the matter.
