CAREERS EDUCATION AND GUIDANCE

[^{F1}45A Guidance as to discharge of duties]^[F2] : schools in England]

- (1) The persons responsible for discharging a relevant duty in relation to a school in England falling within section [^{F3}42A(2)] must, in discharging the duty, have regard to any guidance given from time to time by the Secretary of State.
- (2) A “relevant duty” means a duty under [^{F4}42A(1) or (4)].
