MISCELLANEOUS AND GENERAL

General provisions

57 Minor and consequential amendments, repeals etc. E+W

- (1) The minor and consequential amendments set out in Schedule 7 shall have effect.
- (2) Any reference in any enactment to Part I of Schedule 33 to the ^{M1}Education Act 1996 (appeal committees for hearing admission appeals), or to any provision of that Part of that Schedule, shall (so far as the context permits) be read as including a reference to that Part of that Schedule, or (as the case may be) to that provision of that Part, as applied by paragraph 4 of Schedule 16 or paragraph 3 of Schedule 33A to that Act.
- (3) For the avoidance of doubt, the provisions inserted in the Education Act 1996 by Parts II and III of this Act have effect despite anything in the articles (or, as the case may be, in the instrument or articles) of government of a school to, or in relation to, which those inserted provisions apply or are applied.
- (4) The enactments specified in Schedule 8 are repealed to the extent specified.
