##### PROCEEDINGS IN NORTHERN IRELAND

###### *Notice of devolution issue*

- 26 A court or tribunal shall order notice of any devolution issue which arises in any proceedings before it to be given to the [<sup>F1</sup>Advocate General for Northern Ireland] and the Lord Advocate (unless the person to whom the notice would be given is a party to the proceedings).
