#### TRANSITIONALS AND SAVINGS ABOUT RAILWAYS

##### *Bye-laws*

- 5 (1) The repeal of section 67 of the <sup>M1</sup>Transport Act 1962 does not affect that section, or any provision of that section, as applied by any other enactment.
- (2) Any bye-laws made (or having effect as if made) under—
- (a) section 67 of the <sup>M2</sup>Transport Act 1962, or
  - (b) section 129 of the <sup>M3</sup>Railways Act 1993,
- which are in force immediately before the coming into force of the repeals of those sections shall continue in force; but the Authority may vary or revoke any bye-laws continued in force by this sub-paragraph.
