TRANSITORY MODIFICATIONS

Section 73

- 7 (1) This paragraph applies if paragraph 29 of Schedule 4 to the ^{M1}Youth Justice and Criminal Evidence Act 1999 has not come into force before the commencement of this Act.
- (2) If this paragraph applies, then until the appointed day section 73(4) of this Act shall have effect as if for the words “, an action plan order or a referral order” there were substituted “ or an action plan order ”.
- (3) In this paragraph “the appointed day” means—
- (a) if before the commencement of this Act an order has been made appointing a day for the coming into force of paragraph 29 of Schedule 4 to the ^{M2}Youth Justice and Criminal Evidence Act 1999, the day so appointed;
 - (b) otherwise, such day as the Secretary of State may by order appoint.
